

How to Appeal a Citation

As established by the Board of Directors, there are four requirements for appealing a citation:

1. Completion of the online orientation;
2. Letter to the Rules Committee;
3. Payment of fine; and
4. Payment of \$50 administration fee.

Incomplete appeals will not be presented to the Committee for review.

Should you decide to appeal the citation, you would need to send payment for the fine by check or credit card along with a separate payment of \$50 for payment of the admin fee. The fine payment would not be processed until after the Rules Committee has considered your appeal. The \$50 fee is processed upon receipt. Click here for Credit Card Authorization forms:
