BAREIS MLS® Data Entry & Business Rules

A valid, written listing agreement is required prior to entering a listing into the BAREIS MLS® database. Any listing modification or extension must be authorized by the seller in writing.

BAREIS MLS® accepts exclusive right to sell, seller reserved, open and probate listings. BAREIS may request documentation, including copies of listing and purchase agreements and seller authorizations.

Duplicate Listings	A property may not be entered into more than one property type unless the property meets the Duplicate Listing Guidelines as set by BAREIS MLS®. To view the guidelines from BAREIS MLS® database click here . Unapproved Duplicate Listings will be withdrawn/cancelled from the MLS.			
Fields Requiring MLS Staff Assistance for Revising	Changes to the Original List Price , Listing Date or the Address require the assistance of MLS staff. To request changes to these fields, send a completed Listing Change Form along with the listing agreement to Dataentry@norcalmls.com . The form is available on www.bareis.com or by clicking here .			
Listing Type	A property can be entered as both For Sale and For Lease-Rent simultaneously.			
List Date	The List Date is the date that all necessary signatures have been obtained on the listing agreement or the effective date of the contract.			
On-Market Date	The On-Market Date field reflects the date the listing goes Active on the MLS database.			
Days On Market (DOM)	Days On Market begins calculating from the On-Market Date until the listing becomes Pending.			
Cumulative Days On Market (CDOM)	Cumulative Days On Market tracks the total time on market for a property, regardless of brokerage.			



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Confidential Remarks	The confidential remarks data field is intended to contain agent-to-agent remarks, including showing instructions, financing information and escrow information. Access codes, including alarm codes and gate codes are prohibited in the MLS database.	
Property Description	The property description field is restricted to the physical description and condition of the property. No contact information, website addresses, showing instructions or information directed toward real estate agents or brokers, including compensation or bonuses offered to cooperating brokers may be shown in the property description field. Public remarks appear on client reports and on the public Websites in which BAREIS MLS® participates.	
Unapproved Listings	When entering a future date in the On-Market Date field, the listing will show up as Unapproved . These listings are suppressed from the market and can only be viewed by the listing agent, listing broker and BAREIS MLS® Staff. The listing will automatically approve upon the on-market date and will become Active for other members to view.	
Re-Entering Listings	A property must be W/C or Expired in the MLS for more than 10 days before it may be reentered as a New listing in the MLS. A new listing agreement is required.
